



Welcome to the Glen Falls House!

Located in the picturesque Northern Catskill Mountains. The main house is set on the banks of the Kiskatom Brook. From the observation deck you can see the Glen Falls drop into the gorge 30 feet below and directly across the platform is the Bridal Veil Falls, this creates a unique opportunity to see two waterfalls from the same vantage point.

Our property has been a traditional Catskills resort since at least 1902 and is currently owned & operated by our family. We offer a beautiful setting, with comfortable rooms and lots to do.

The resort encompasses 46 acres, with waterfalls and swimming holes, and offers extensive hiking & biking trails. There are two large banquet rooms that can be set up for presentations and events. If you want to stay on the resort for meals, dining packages are available or you can eat in our tavern. The food is prepared by our chef who is a graduate of the Culinary Institute of America so either way it will be a great meal.

We are best known for our family reunions and special events. There are more than a dozen groups that hold reunions annually or biannually at the resort. This is because of the relaxed setting, clean and comfortable rooms, great food and the many activities that are available for all ages. We also hold events like Wine & Dine weekends where we have a wine tasting, complimentary wine with dinner and more. The Glen Falls House is the ideal place for your next event.

Near-by attractions include: Hudson-Athens, Saugerties, Rondout, & Esopus Meadows lighthouses, Kaaterskill Falls, Windham Mountain Adventure Park, The Thomas Cole National Historic Site, Hudson River School Art Trail, Bronck Museum and much more.

Neighboring towns to visit: Windham, Saugerties, Woodstock, and Rhinebeck just to name a few all offer great shopping complete with antique stores, local artisans and restaurants.

Directions:

New York State Thruway North to exit 20 (Saugerties) After toll, make left onto Route 32 North.

Turn right at first light and continue on Route 32 North. Stay on route 32 past the entrance to the NY Thruway. After about 6 miles you will come to a blinking light. Turn right and continue on Route 32 North.

After approximately 5 miles, make left onto Hearts Content Road. *There is a large Purling/Round Top sign shaped like an arrow. Go about 2.5 miles and make left (first left you can make) onto Winter Clove Road.

The Glen Falls House is about ½ mile up on right.

Catskill Region Guided Photo Op Tours - October 15th - 17th

Come join us for a one of a kind experience! Our photo guides will take you to some of the best places to shoot in the northern Catskills during the Fall. Guests will enjoy a 3-day, 2-night stay at the Glen Falls House Resort. The package includes all meals and guided tours.

The weekend starts with a family style dinner on Friday night with an overview of the planned tour. A full, hot breakfast will be served before you head out on your Saturday morning shoot. A hearty lunch will be served back at the resort with a little time to relax. Then, there will be another guided tour in the afternoon with dinner waiting for you once you return. Sunday includes both breakfast and lunch. This will be a self-guided day, where you will have a chance to explore on your own, revisit sites from the previous day or shoot our on-site waterfalls and grounds.

Package price is \$168 per person (\$84/night) based on double occupancy in rooms with two full-sized beds. \$190 (\$95/night) for singles in room with one full-sized bed.

Locations and subjects will be chosen based on current weather conditions. Transportation is not provided. We will carpool and caravan to the various locations. Participants should know their equipment as this is guided tour and not an educational workshop. Some walking or light hiking over uneven terrain is possible. Please dress accordingly; tours go out rain or shine.
